Direct instruction in support of the Science Fair takes place in Integrated Science 2, 3 and 4. All Integrated Science 3-4 students are required to participate. Additionally, the Science Fair is a required forum for the Honors Chemistry and Senior Research Classes. The Science Fair is open to all Redwood students. The fair is conducted using the rules of the International Science and Engineering Fair. Entries in the RHS Science Fair have the potential to move on to the Marin County Science Fair, The SF Bay Area Science Fair, the California State Science Fair, and The International Science and Engineering Fair.
